- MinuteClinic medical staff treat common illnesses and minor wounds, and provide vaccinations, wellness services and lab tests.

#### What if I'm not at home and need care?

You can call a doctor anytime by using Teladoc<sup>®</sup> telemedicine services. If your health or life is in serious danger, call **911** or go to the nearest hospital. You'll be covered even if the hospital is not in our network.

#### If I'm being treated by a doctor outside the network when I join Aetna Premier Care Network, is that treatment covered?

Yes, but you will need to request transition-of-care coverage. If your request is approved, you can stay with your current doctor for a limited time at the highest benefits level. Transition-of-care coverage does *not* cover:

- Care received at health care centers
- Durable medical equipment (DME)
- Prescription drugs

You'll need to use network health care centers, DME vendors and pharmacies to get coverage for those services during your transition-of-care period.
