



Clear vision is in sight.

If glasses or contact lenses aren't what you envisioned, it might be time to consider LASIK. It's the most advanced procedure to correct nearsightedness, farsightedness or astigmatism, and millions of people have chosen it.

LASIK could be right for you, too.

LASIK surgery is surprisingly simple to explain. An ophthalmologist (a provider who specializes in surgical treatment of the eyes) uses a laser to reshape the cornea at the front of the eye, improving the way the eye focuses. The procedure only takes 5 to 15 minutes, however, you should allow for 2 hours in-office on the day of treatment.

The best part? The results of LASIK treatment are immediate. Most patients return to work and normal activities the next day.

You may be a good candidate for laser vision correction if you:

- Are at least 18 years old
- Are nearsighted, farsighted or have astigmatism
- Are in general good health with no conditions affecting the eye
- Have a stable vision prescription for at least one year
